

Additional Programs of Study after Degree Conferral

Students on whom the University has already conferred the Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science degree may satisfy the requirements for an additional major, minor, or certificate of curricular study by successfully completing a minimum of sixteen semester hours in each of two additional semesters while enrolled as a regular full-time student in the College and by fulfilling all requirements for the additional major, minor, or certificate of curricular study. A total of 32 semesters hours must be earned even if fewer are required to satisfy the requirements of the program of study. A student upon whom the University has already conferred the Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science degree who subsequently satisfies the requirements for an additional major will not receive a second bachelor's degree and a different degree will not be substituted for the one previously conferred.
